The training, led by the People's Voice Media and hosted by Per Esempio Onlus, was designed to learn how to exchange knowledge with the community about what came out of the previous interviews and write policy briefings through participatory learning activities; it involved youth workers and young people from Italy, Portugal, Hungary, Germany, Lithuania, Denmark and England.
